





Overview




ØSimilar to federal management **ØBased on constant fishing mortality rate** à Basis for quota **Ø**Target and threshold biomass **à** Overfished or not overfished ØTarget and threshold fishing mortality rate à Overfishing is occurring or overfishing is not occurring ØMay 1 fishing season starts, 2 periods



ØRate of removal of fish from a population ØUses spawning stock biomass (SSB) ØOverfishing or overfishing not occurring ØCurrently in rebuilding F = 0.11 \emptyset 2008/2009 Quota = 8 million pounds à 2007/2008 Overfishing not occurring ØF threshold = 0.39 once rebuilt à Potential for increased quota



ØAmount of reproductive females in the stock **ØUses SSB** Ø3 year moving average à Includes year before and after ØTarget = 167,000 mt \emptyset Threshold = 83,500 mt \emptyset 2006 SSB = 141,350 mt à Not overfished, but not rebuilt

ØDivided btw. 2 fishing periods

- ØPeriod 1: May 1 October 31; 57.9% of quota
- ØPeriod 2: November 1 April 30; 42.1% of quota

ØPaybacks and rollovers by period


ØPossession limits
